A WORK IN PROGRESS

The SHCJ American Province Associates is a work in progress. The vision of the Associates has been discussed for some time. In April 2002, the first gathering of persons related to the American Province who were identified as Associates was held at Rosemont College. The inspiration of that meeting was a clear desire to move ahead with defining, identifying, and organizing the Associates. An Associates Team was authorized to guide the next steps. The members of this group are: Connie Bush, Jim Ewing, Gail Ferrailo, Catherine Quinn, SHCJ, Mary Samson, SHCJ, and Mariellen Whalen.

The Associates Team is aware of a variety of motivations and levels of participation that have developed in recent years.

The motivations are stirred by several factors. These include:

- A desire for growth in the spirituality of Cornelia Connelly
- Friend and family of SHCJ
- Those involved in shared ministry
- > People who pray for the needs of the Society and its members
- > Those called to social action through the work of the society
- > Those educated by SHCJ wishing a continued connection
- People of other faiths with common goals

Several levels of participation for American Province Associates have been noted. These are:

- Collaborative member attends regular meetings either at a local setting or participates in the national network
- Supportive member is connected through the newsletter, personal prayer, or by relationship with a member of the Society
- Periodic member participates either in a yearly retreat or gathering for spiritual growth or is involved in a particular service activity of the Society

There are other motivations and levels of participation that may be present among Associates. We invite all Associates to share these. For two years a planning group has worked on the development of by-laws and articles of incorporation. A search has begun for an Executive Director of Cornelia Ministries.
