September 10, 2021 – Actions for Our Own Dear Planet

Reduce carbon pollution. Fossil fuel is the #1 source of carbon pollution in the U.S.

- **Divest** from fossil fuels, **reinvest** in renewable energy, and **ask your bank** to fund renewable energy, not fossil fuels. The Vatican recommends fossil fuel divestment: Disinvest from fossil fuel, Vatican recommends
- Support environmentally positive companies by your purchases and investments. Boycott companies that damage Mother Earth and/or contact their leadership to register your concerns. In Laudato Si' (par. 206) Pope Francis praises "boycotting certain products." This site lists companies deserving boycotts and recommends how to judge good ones: Boycotts List | Ethical Consumer. Take action on fossil fuel and energy; bottled water (Nestlé is now called Blue Triton and its brands include Poland Spring, Ice Mountain, Deer Park, Arrowhead); banks that bankroll fossil fuel production. Avoid companies operating throughout the Amazon rainforest that are linked to Indigenous rights abuses, hazardous pollution, corruption, biodiversity loss, and climate warming.
- Pray this week that the leadership of the above companies will respond positively to boycotts and consumer suggestions. Boycotts work: History of Successful Boycotts | Ethical Consumer.
- Reduce your use of fossil fuels. Aim at zero use of plastic, which is made from fossil
 fuels. Increase consumption of organic and non-beef alternatives. Reduce car, truck, and
 flight pollution, which is especially harmful in low-income communities and
 communities of color, causing thousands of premature deaths and billions in health care
 costs every year. Avoid idling or speeding. Share rides. Click here to send a comment to
