

2022 HOLY CHILD SPIRIT HONOREE Marina Alma Marmolejo

This year's recipient of the Holy Child Spirit Award, Marina Alma Marmolejo, MPH, is a living testament to the Holy Child traditions of faith, justice, service, and compassion.

Marina, an anti-poverty advocate, is breaking new ground with innovative approaches to support communities experiencing

homelessness. She understands the power of technology, combined with real-time data and human-centered design, to create sustainable solutions for the most vulnerable among us.

As an undergraduate at Loyola Marymount University, Marina spent four days on the streets of Skid Row in Los Angeles, including sleeping in shelters, to better understand homelessness. From that point forward, she dedicated her academic and professional career to fighting chronic homelessness.

Currently, Marina manages a \$400 million rental assistance program for Connecticut residents financially impacted by COVID-19. Marina ensures that the state's online application process is available to marginalized communities, who often lack access to technology. She is at the forefront of moving all statewide applications to an online platform and creating space for critical conversations about technological advances.

Prior to working at the Connecticut Department of Housing, Marina attended the Yale School of Public Health, where she earned a Master of Public Health. While at Yale, Marina founded DreamKit, a groundbreaking tech-nonprofit to support youth experiencing homelessness. DreamKit connects young adults without housing to mentors and employment opportunities in their communities, where they learn essential skills and earn money to cover their basic needs. She also was awarded two Yale teaching fellowships, as the Teaching Fellow for Social Justice and Health Equity and the Lead Teaching Fellow for Practice-Based Community Health Research.

Marina, who has published numerous papers on homelessness, has served in many volunteer roles, including as a member for Connecticut's Commissioner on Racial Equity and Public Health.

Holy Child traditions and service run deep in Marina's family. Along with her brother and sister, Marina attended Mayfield Junior School of the Holy Child Jesus, before moving onto Mayfield Senior School, which is her mother and sister's alma mater, too. At Mayfield, she embraced leadership opportunities and learned the principles of social justice, which helped to shape her into the anti-poverty advocate she is today.

2022 FAITH IN ACTION HONOREE

Margaret M. Morrow

Having spent decades ensuring equal access to justice for all, Margaret Morrow is the embodiment of Cornelia Connelly's call to "Actions Not Words."

For the last five and a half years, Margaret served as the president and CEO of Public Counsel, a nonprofit public interest law firm that

provides free legal services to low-income communities and advocates for policy changes that address inequality and homelessness. Prior to joining Public Counsel, Margaret served for 18 years as a judge on the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California. While on the bench, Margaret led the effort to build a new federal courthouse in Los Angeles and was integral in creating the Central District's alternative dispute resolution program.

Margaret is a past president of the State Bar of California, the first woman elected to that position. She has served as president of the Los Angeles County Bar Association and its Young Attorneys Section. In that role, she was instrumental in organizing a pro bono Domestic Violence Clinic. She also started a pro bono hospice/AIDS clinic to help low-income clients with end-of-life legal issues. As president of the Los Angeles County Bar Association, Margaret spearheaded the association's adoption of a Pro Bono Policy, which led to a significant increase in the hours devoted to helping the poor. Currently, as a member of the Legal Services Corporation's Rural Justice Task Force, Margaret is exploring innovative ways to expand free legal services for rural, low-income communities.

In addition to her work with impacted communities, Margaret is a member of the Board of Directors of the Carrie Estelle Doheny Foundation, which provides support to Catholic schools in the Los Angeles Archdiocese and to multiple Los Angeles County organizations serving the poor. Additionally, she served multiple terms on the Mayfield Senior School of the Holy Child Jesus School Board of Trustees and on other nonprofit boards and commissions.

Margaret earned her bachelor's degree magna cum laude from Bryn Mawr College in 1971 and her J.D. degree cum laude from Harvard Law School in 1974.

Committed to serving those in need, Margaret's life epitomizes "faith in action" and the importance of creating a just and equitable society for all. As Margaret stated, "Getting to be a part of the fight for civil rights, justice, and equity has been the honor of a lifetime."

South Central LAMP also provides family advocacy, a weekly food distribution, and Camp LAMP, a summer learning experience that incorporates STEAM activities and field trips for families.






