At the beginning of my formation, my understanding and experience of incarnation was that of God becoming human for my sake.

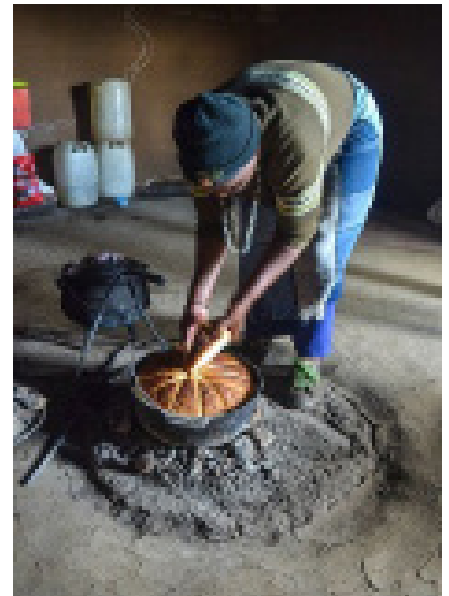
