"Nourished from the well-springs of this heavenly fountain, and fed in the pasture of His Divine Love, we are to run with ardor in the way that He has pointed out, and to employ every effort to lead others, especially Catholic children, to taste and to embrace the sweet yoke which He offers them, laboring with all our strength to increase love of, devotion to, and imitation of the interior and exterior virtues of the hidden life of our most sweet Jesus, thus endeavoring to fulfill the end and aim of this little Society, which is called of the Holy Child Jesus - Rule, S.H.C.J.

The Mission of Cornelia Connelly and the Society of the Holy Child Jesus

A charism is given by God for the good of God's people. In Cornelia's words, "God has chosen to need men and women in every age to reveal his love and to make known the reality of the Incarnation." Cornelia's charism led her to found the Society of the Holy Child Jesus to do just that.

In an early version of the SHCJ Rule of Life, Cornelia expressed the mission in these words:

"...laboring with all our strength to increase the love, devotion and the imitation of the interior and exterior virtues of the hidden life of our most sweet Jesus..."

Responding to the needs of her time, the mission was carried out in the context of the "education of females of all classes of society."

In contemporary language, the mission reads:

For this is our mission: to help others believe that God lives and acts in them and in our world, and to rejoice in God's presence.

Responding to the needs of our times, the mission is carried out through all aspects of education.
